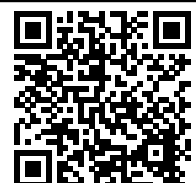
Beautiful, glowing madder-red dominates the field of this lovely little 'chanteh' or vanity-bag, made by the tribes of the Khamseh Confederacy at the end of the 19th century. Surrounding the green central cross pattern are 4 well-fed chickens - rare to find on small bags. The bag is complete with plain-weave back in narrow horizontal bands of colour and it is in near-mint condition. Size: 28cm x 23cm 11" x 9".
