One of the better examples of ATO clocks that we're had. Totally authentic and in excellent condition. Although the original batteries are no longer available to power them - our horologist has adapted the mechanism to take a modern battery. There's a little BIO below for those interested. About ATO ATO is short for Hatot (Leon Hatot) Léon Hatot born 22.04.1883 died 11.09.1953. He was a French clock maker and is famous for producing one of the first battery operated clocks in the 1920s. He patented the classic form of pendulum which used a magnet and coils to impulse the pendulum.

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
