The 'palette' shaped cartouche that the duty mark is in, denotes a specific period of assay between 11th October 1805 - 28th May 1805. This smaller Assay period makes the mark sought after by collector's. Maker :- John Reily. Height :- 2.5 cms (without chain). Width :- 2.25 cms.
