## Description

This salt-bag - 'namakdan' in Persian - is very finely brocaded on both front and back, and decorated with long braided goat-hair tassels, symbolically representing good luck and protection. Woven by Baluch nomads in the border area of south-eastern Persia and Baluchistan, it was made around 1900-1910. Size: 28cm x 78cm (11" x 30.7") including tassels.
