With a single central opening door , flanked by canted corners. The door front is decorated with floral Art Nouveau style inlaid decoration in various fruitwoods. Further chequer banding inlay is found throughout. The top of the robe is surmounted by dentil corning and thumb nail moldings. The door opens to reveal an interior with a high level shelf, twin hanging rails and a range of hooks. The lock is stamped with the makers monogram "S P B" (for Shapland Petter Barnstaple) and its handle bears the registration number. We have had this stunning item sympathetically cleaned and waxed in our workshops, it is now offered for sale in excellent condition with a great colour and patina. Dimensions: Width 136cms Depth 50cms Height 207cms Shapland & Petter was a Devonshire company whose Arts & Crafts furniture is at last receiving the recognition it deserves.
