A superb quality Victorian silver porringer. This superior example is of excellent gauge Britannia standard silver (95.84 silver as opposed to the regular fineness of Sterling 92.5). There is a wonderful planished look to the body, echoing an early 'Arts and Crafts' style finish. The body features a half panel of acanthus leaf decoration and has twin cast mythical dolphin handles. Porringers were originally used as food vessels and in particular porridge, but nowadays they are widely collected and are of course, still perfectly usable as bowls.
