A truly exquisite, early solid silver berry spoon made in the Regency period. The silversmith's work is of the highest quality, which can be seen on the bowl of the spoon which is highly decorated with fruits, berries and flowers. The handle is equally exquisite with lovely floral decoration. The back of the spoon handle bears clear hallmarks of the Lion Passant for sterling silver and the Leopard's Head for the London Assay office with a date mark: 1819 along with the maker's mark for the renowned and very collectible silversmith: William Bateman.

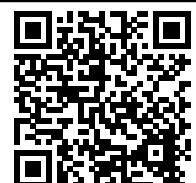
