In the Queen Anne style. The serpentine shaped top and all of the drawer fronts are cross banded. Each of the drawers is fitted with its original brass handles. This chest has canted corners fitted with feather-dart banding veneers. It stands on charming squat cabriole legs. We have had this lovely chest cleaned and waxed in our workshops. It has a lovely mellow colour and patina and is now offered for sale in very good condition, ready to go straight into the home. Dimensions: Width 84cms Depth 50cms Height 96cms Waring and Gillow a potted history: Waring & Gillow is a noted firm of English furniture manufacturers formed in 1897 by the merger of Gillow of Lancaster and Waring of Liverpool. The firm of Gillow's of Lancaster can be traced back to the luxury furniture and furnishings firm founded by Robert Gillow (1704-72) in 1730. Robert Gillow served an apprenticeship as a joiner. During the 1730s he began to exploit the lucrative West Indies trade exporting mahogany furniture and im...

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
