In burl and straight grain walnut and as always with Maurice Adams furniture they are beautifully made. This pair of chairs are also in very good condition and have recently been recovered in white faux leather. 900mm high, 500mm wide, 560mm deep and 460mm seat height. Circa 1930. Maurice Adams saw himself as the natural successor to the great furniture makers of the eighteenth century and had ambitious plans for 20th-century British interior design, including a proposed 'Maurice Adams house', in which the architecture and interior furnishings would be designed entirely by Adams throughout, in a streamlined, Georgian style. All Adams's furniture was made by hand in Gloucester and displayed in Adams's showroom in Portman Square, London.
