A good quality fully restored walnut French wall regulator clock, dating circa 1870. The high quality and substantial 14 day day movement with unusual pin wheel escapement and sweep centre calendar. 14 day running duration with a further 7 day reserve - 21 day in total. The finely made spring driven double train movement striking the hours and half hour on a blued steel curled gong. Beautiful compensated grid iron pendulum of the highest quality - again very heavy and substantial. Circular convex enamel dial with Roman numerals to the outer chapter and sweep centre calendar to the centre surrounded by a heavy cast brass bezel. Fine quality blued steel hands. The substantial walnut case with glazed door and sides, with the original lock and key. Carved decoration to the upper section and shaped/moulded base with finial and brass circular wall spurs. A very fine and unusual clock restored to the highest level. All of our clocks have been sympathetically restored and have been expertly vetted for originality and good working order.
