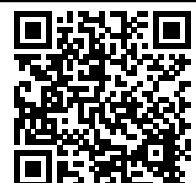

The makers initials are also present for Thomas Diller. The lid has a cap which can be turned to reveal an open little hole which is attached to an integral straw which sits within the flask, once used it can be turned to cover the hole.
