Maker's marks are also clearly visible: Charles Shipway. Condition: This salt spoon is in great antique condition. No visible dents to the silver and not misshapen. The gilt in the bowl is a good colour and not worn. The hallmarks and maker's marks are very clearly visible. Hallmarks: London 1835 by Charles Shipway. Measurements: Length: 10.2 cm approx.
