George Henry Harlow George Henry Harlow (10 June 1787 – 4 February 1819), was a highly regarded English portrait painter Harlow was born in St. James's Street, London. Harlow decided to devote himself to painting he was placed under Henry De Cort, the landscape-painter. He next worked under Samuel Drummond, A.R.A., the portrait-painter, but after about a year entered the studio of Sir Thomas Lawrence (president of the Royal Academy).
