Six delightful cut glass champagne flutes, assembled to form a 'harlequin' set. Harlequin sets are individual examples placed together to celebrate a combination of their similarities and differences. This fine set all date from the mid-Victorian era and are detailed as follows. 1. Plain form conical flute with plain stem and polished pontil. 2. Slice cut flute with bladed knop, plain stem and polished pontil. 3. Tulip slice cut bowl with slice cut stem and polished pontil. 4. Tulip bowl with petal cut to base of bowl and cut hourglass stem with teardrop blown through. Polished pontil. 5. Slice cut flute with bladed collar and plain stem. Polished pontil to base. 6.
