Ltd was added in 1900. A pretty little 1/2 Gill (1/8th. pint) pewter measure with capacity marks to the rim. A pretty little 1/2 Gill pewter measure with touch marks to the top rims A tiny 1/4 Gill pewter measure with indistinct marks to the rim. Circa 1850 -1880 H:5", 13 cms, W:3.5", 9 cms, D:3.5", 9 cms.
