A finely engraved dial center with makers name , calendar and seconds, as well as the full silvered chapter ring . A good quality and substantial 8 day duration movement which strikes the hour on a bell . A superb 'Flame' mahogany case with the classic long trunk door with arch to mirror the Hood .
