A magnificent and most unusual Victorian Ice Bucket made from glass and silverplate by the top notch London silversmith, Mappin Brothers. The bucket has a folding swing handle and is lucky enough to retain it's original drainer which sits on a shelf inside the bucket allowing any melted ice to run through the drainer away from the ice. It is the drainer that is struck with the mark for the Mappin Brothers and dates to around 1870. What makes this piece most unusual is the etched designs around the sides of classical male figures on horseback, quite outstanding. Excellent condition.
