Description

Stevenard of Boulogne was a very well known maker of automata, he is better known for his inventive mechanical Dolls and life like figures rather than clocks, however this Carriage clock is quite unusual and rare. The clock retains the original Lever escapement with engraved balance cock, and is countwheel striking on a bell, the case retains the solid, engraved back door and the dial is surprisingly good for a clock of this early period of Carriage clock development. The case is 'multi - piece' rather than 'one piece' like so many of the early clocks. The engraving is still quite crisp and has the original gilding.
