Description

Early C20th brass-framed inlaid marquetry top coffee table on 'faux' bamboo style base. Smart 'sun-burst' design mahogany and satinwood panel-top table, the large 'fanned' oval with a central patera and spandrels to the corners, fitted with a plate glass top protector, and raised upon a lacquered brass base of faux bamboo design. Shaped inverted end frame with lateral stretcher supports. The brass base has an aged patina, and matches the colour of the brass surround of the top panel. The panel being of late C18th George III period origin, and had been mounted into this bespoke 'made-to-measure' brass base during the first part of the C20th. Would complement a period style room setting, providing a practical and decorative low centre or coffee table. H 13" W 53" D 24" England c.1920
