It is finely modelled in ormolu (finely gilded bronze), beautifully finished and in stunning condition. It is mounted with beautiful Sevres style porcelain, each piece is signed faintly on the reverse by the artist. It is decorated with a cobalt blue background, the panel below the dial is delicately painted with a scene of a lady and a child amongst classical ruins. The dial itself is decorated with a bird and floral swags. It is lettered in white cartouches against the blue background enamel 'jewel' half-hour markers. It is complete with original gilt brass hands. Above the dial is a porcelain urn with ormolu handles and a pineapple finial. To the sides are floral swags and goddess masks. Please note that this style of clock does not have a glazed bezel over the dial or a rear door. The French movement is by Japy Freres and has the makers mark on the backplate along with that of the retailer. It is of high quality and is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully overhauled by our clockmaker. Pendulum is a...

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
