The front has gilded lettering and bears the title Hollands. Hollands was the original name for Gin which originated from the Low Countries, notable the Netherlands and Belgium. The gilded lettering has some losses, commensurate with age and use. Inside the decanter there is a burst bubble, not damage and part of the original manufacturing process. Origin :- English.
