This stunning Inkwell was made by Fenton Bros. Ltd. in 1902. The oval cut glass inkwell is mounted with a circular Solid Silver Lid with plain centre and a geometrically patterned border. The inkwell is mounted on an oval Solid Silver Tray which stands on four ball feet and which has a superbly embossed and crimped border with plain centre and two blank cartouche. To hold the inkwell in place there is a Solid Silver Holder which has the same pattern and design as the border around the lid of the inkwell, and this has an integral dip pen holder making this an unusual and rare item. Free from any added initials, monograms or engravings, this exceptional inkwell is in superb condition and would look fabulous on any desk or would enhance any collection. (Note: Pen not included).
