A very good pair of 19th century bronze figures of young girls, one offering fruit from a basket and the other is hand spinning flax. Both on original marble socles, the base of one figure signed A. Mayer. . When removed from socles, the bronzes are hand numbered to the underside of each figure - 15885 and 6341. Original brass fixings. . A German sculptor, Alois Mayer was born in 1855 (d. 1939) and these bronzes date from the late 19th Century. . The socles have some very small nibbles to the bottom edge but otherwise are in sound and fine condition. Both figures in excellent original condition with a most attractive colour and patination to the bronze. Extremely life like and finely cast. . Dimensions are: 14 inches high and 5 inches wide max.
