This superbly decorated Solid Silver Playing Card Case was hallmarked in Chester in 1898 and made by the much sought after silversmiths of Nathan & Hayes. The box is embossed with a floral and 'C' Scroll design on all four sides and on the lid. There is a blank cartouche on the lid and the box is free from any added engravings or initials. Made from good gauge silver, this lovely playing card box is in superb condition especially considering it is almost 120 years old. Note: The box was designed for slightly smaller playing cards than normal and so it comes complete with two packs of vintage playing cards which fit perfectly. The cards are supplied in their original box, have not been used and are still sealed. This excellent piece would make a wonderful gift or add to any collection.

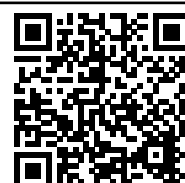
