Highly decorative pair of ebonised base stools with stylised cabriole legs with faceted sides, terminating in well-carved lion's paw claw feet, joined by turned cross stretchers with a central roundel. The tops and deep frieze sides upholstered and covered with original decorative geometric design needlework covers with deep-frilled braid edge details. Excellent condition throughout. Some minor wear to ebonised feet, which could be refinished if desired. Useful pair of stools to add a feel of period Colonial style and exoticism to an interior scheme.
