Early 20th Century Mira pocket watch with chain. The watch has a Swiss stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The movement is signed Mira. The company was founded in 1896 and was named after the Mira star, discovered in 1596 by David Fabricius, and it means 'wonderful' and 'astonishing' in Latin. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover (there is a scratch across this inner cover). The watch itself measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The white metal case is in lovely condition, as is the lens. The white enamel dial is in lovely condition and has blued steel Breguet style hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track with 24 hour numbers. The watch comes with a single chain which measures 31cm long including the T-bar and the clasp. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. Free worldwide shipping
