Depicting a Welsh bard in laurel wreath and flowing robes playing a small Celtic harp, his eyes raised to heaven. Set within a border of scrolling acanthus leaves topped with the three feathers and the Ich Dien motto of the Prince of Wales. With another harp and repeats of the three feathers to the seat cover. With a small hole and some wear to the seat cover, otherwise excellent condition, the frame has been cleaned and waxed in our workshops. Dimensions: width 27½", depth 28", height 45".
