An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. The Skarratt family of clockmakers worked in Worcester, Kington and Hay in the 19th century. John Skarratt is listed in Loomes' 'Watccmakers and Clockmakers of The World' book as working from 1828-1860. Height 6ft 5 " / 196 cms.
