This super late 18th century LOWESTOFT PORCELAIN TEAPOT, in the DOLL'S HOUSE PATTERN, dates from circa 1770. The TEAPOT is in generally good condition for Lowestoft. There are some damages to the collar - the main area is inline with the spout (please see photograph). There is a hairline to the lower base of the handle and old chips to the footrim which are shown in the close-up photograph. The LID has an old 2.5 cm hairline and a small chip to the underside of the lip. There is no restoration. The colours are strong and vibrant.
