The dish is an oval shape that is slightly raised on either side, adding to the lovely lines of the Salt and sits on an oval foot. The silver has a heraldic emblem in the centre depicting a Lion and serpent. A gadrooned rim at the top and around the foot further enhances the aesthetic appeal. The gilded interior is a lovely golden yellow. Very clear and crisp hallmarks are visible on the base for The London Assay Office with a date mark for 1804 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. The maker's mark is also very clear for the Georgian Silversmiths Robert & Samuel Hennell. Condition: This Salt dish is in great antique condition.
