The leaf fronds of a gilded patina and the grain ears of corn in silver patination. The whole sheaf bound with a simulated rope-twist binding. Topped with loose circular plate glass panels. Of a type made iconic by the use of such models in the Parisian apartment of Coco Chanel the reknown French couture and fashion designer.
