Description

A superb George III mahogany dressing chest raised on boxwood strung square tapering legs terminating with original castors. The colour and patina are excellent. The cross banded top of this wonderful Georgian chest lifts to reveal a good sized mirror and various lidded compartments, all intact. The drawers with ring handles, run well and have fine boxwood and ebony stringing. This stringing is continued on the sides of the chest, an indication of a high quality piece. The condition of the chest is very good, it stands well with no wobbles. There is a very minor short crack to the top, this can be seen in the photographs with very careful scrutiny, it is commensurate with age and use and does not detract from the appearance of the chest.
