Retaining the original finish with outstanding colour and figuring throughout. The cabinet having a moulded panelled breakfront door and raised on a moulded plinth. The door opens to reveal a selection of drawers and slides and 2 velvet lined compartments which are for Jewellery and watch boxes. Retaining all the original fittings including lock and key. English, Circa 1880, attributed to Holland & Sons.
