This beautiful and complete VICTORIAN BLUE & WHITE TEA SET was made for a child by CHARLES MEIGH & SON of the Old Hall Pottery, Hanley (1851-1861). It bears the Factory Mark which includes the Pattern Name 'MOSS ROSE' - a very pretty pattern. The TEA SET consists of a Teapot, Sugar Bowl, Milk Jug and 6 cups and saucers. It has a good, bright glaze. This TEA SET displays beautifully. There are some old damages but this is always the case with china that has been played with by children. The close-up of the sugar bowl shows the worst chip. The Teapot, Milk Jug, three cups and 5 saucers have no damage at all. There is no restoration.
