Description

A 1930s Kays Masterpiece silver pocket watch in superb condition. William Kay was originally employed as a jeweller's assistant and worked for Skarratt & Co of Worcester. In 1890, he started his own company, Kays of Worcester and his early catalogue shows that he supplied jewellery, clocks, watches and timepieces to Worcester and its vicinity. Kays subsequently bought Skarratt & Co in 1896 and acquired the contract to supply Great Western Railway with clocks and watches. This particular watch has a Swiss stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch itself measures 50.3mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside both of the case backs for Birmingham 1934 with a case maker's mark for the Dennison Watch Case Company. The case is in very good condition, with only the odd minor mark from use. The engine turned detail is still lovely and crisp. The watch glass is in good order. The signed white enamel dial is in lovely condition with blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box.
