A superb, late Georgian, silver vinaigrette. The pattern is a trim engine turned design. There is a neat hinge that opens and closes well, and when opened a fine gilt floral grill is revealed, along with a completely gilded interior. Clearly visible to the interior base are the hallmarks for the London Assay Office with a date mark for 1790, along with the silversmith's maker's mark for Thomas Phipps & Edward Robinson. These hallmarks are also visible on the interior of the lid. The vinaigrette is a lovely size. Condition: This vinaigrette is in great antique condition. There are some very minor small superficial scratches, commensurate with the age, that I mention for accuracy only. Hallmarks and maker's marks: London 1790 by Thomas Phipps & Edward Robinson Measurements: Height: 1.32 cm approx. Depth: 2.69 cm approx. Width: 3.86 cm approx. Weight: 33.65 grams approx.
