Description

Victorian mahogany Wellington chest Here we have this Wellington chest made of mahogany. The drawers are secured when not in use by 2 locking bars that open on hinges. One locking bar is secured with a lock and key and the other with sliding bolts at the top and bottom. The locking bar means that you do not need a multitude of keys to lock the drawers. The name Wellington chest derives from the Duke of Wellington who had such an item made for him on campaign. It is fitted 7 graduated drawers with brass Prince of Wales feathers handles. 7 drawer examples are sometimes referred to as 'each day of the week' chests. Although I'm sceptical of this as each drawer is differing in size They are the original office filing cabinet 108cms high (42 1/2ins) 41cms deep (16ins) 60cms wide (23 1/2ins)
