The possibly associated lids each with a Foo or Lion dog finial. Each vase decorated in typical Imari pattern and colour palette of deep cobalt and ink blue hues with iron red and gilt highlights upon a pale background. All in excellent original condition with no damage or repairs. Would work well on a mantle or atop a pediment. Exotic Japanese Imari of this period was a staple content of the English Country home decorative scheme with its vibrant colours and designs.
