The silver plated blades are marked one side for the silversmith, Allen and Darwin of Sheffield. The other side has an English design registration number for the year 1893. This set comes with it's original solid Mahogany presentation box lined in navy blue velvet. The box has an inset plate marked with another English registration number for the year 1898. There is another inset plaque engraved with the retailer's details, John Hall and Co. 56, King St., Manchester. The set remains in superb condition.
