Decorative 'matched' pair of late C19th Syrian hexagonal side tables. Interesting matched "pair" of Damascus tables with ebonised and inlaid fruit-wood and mother-of-Pearl or nacre shell decoration. Each of matching proportions and design with almost identical decoration . One table with an Arabic inscription or calligraphic turgrah, to it's centre , the other with a blank ebonised panel . The hexagonal inlaid tops with central overlaid star design, banded shell-inlaid edges and raised on arcaded frames with panels of shell decoration and inlaid geometric wooden inlays. In good clean , original condition. Minor losses to inlay commensurate with age and use. Useful pair of end or drinks tables to bring symmetry and exoticism to a room setting.
