Of very good construction in walnut with attractive burr walnut veneers. This vitrine is of bow fronted form and has a single front opening door which accesses a shelved and lined interior. The cabinet is decorated throughout with carved applied floral swags which are highlighted in gilt. It stands on squat cabriole legs with characteristic shell motifs (also in gilt) to the knees. This charming vitrine is offered for sale in excellent original condition with a good colour and patina. Please note that the interior lining paper is stained to the bottom shelf; we can have the cabinet re-lined should you wish.
