Good William IV period rosewood work or sewing table. The table with two drawers and a pull out work box underneath. The drawers with cock beading, original turned knobs and mahogany drawer linings. The table is finished at the back as can be seen in the photos. The table top has two lift up flaps with wooden hinge supports. The base is of trestle end design with scroll shape feet. The material to the work box is OK but could be changed if required by any good upholsterer. The veneers used on the top have a lovely grain pattern and the table is a nice colour with good patination. SIZE; 20" wide with the leaves down by 14 1/2" deep by 28 1/2" high. With the leaves up the table is 33" wide. CIRCA; 1830 - 1835
