The lid opens and closes nicely and clear hallmarks are visible on the inside lip for the Chester Assay Office with a date mark for 1904 along with the Lion Passant indicating sterling silver and maker's marks for Payton Pepper & Sons. Condition: In good original condition appropriate for age. There is some minor superficial surface scratching to the case commensurate with age and visible due to the plain polished surface of the item.
