## Description

A fine Queen Anne period Bristol longcase clock. An oak case with flat moulded hood pediment with blind fretwork. Front and rear brass capped hood columns and side glass apertures. A slim, well proportioned case with moulded trunk door edging. A high quality brass and silvered dial with original blued steel hands. A finely engraved dial centre with inner border chased engraving and decoration around the date aperture. A seconds dial and ringed winding holes. An 8-day duration, 5 pillar mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Brass cased weights. John Culliford of Bristol worked from 1692-1716. He is noted and well documented in A J Moores' 'The Clockmakers of Bristol' book as making Lantern clocks and longcase. He is also recorded in Loomes 'The Early Clockmakers of Great Britain' as repairing the church clock from 1706.
