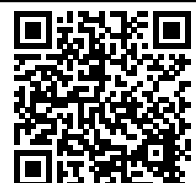
A rare example of mid 18th Century craftsmanship. This is a fine George II silver snuff box with mother-of-pearl panels to the lid and the base. The body is oval and opens via a hinged lid. The mother-of-pearl in the lid is decorated in a cross-hatch design, set in a diamond shape. A desirable and collectable piece of Georgian silver. The rim to the lid has some small ripples and there is a small crack to the mother-of-pearl in the base, shown in photo and commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Unmarked but tests as silver.
