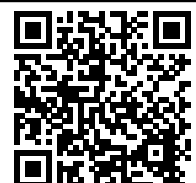
A rare George III silver 'Harvey Sauce' condiment Label. This wonderful piece is oval in shape with a feathered border. The words Harvey Sauce are pricked to the centre. The label is supported on a belcher chain and to the reverse are full hallmarks. Harvey sauce is a bottled relish introduced in the late 18th century, and becoming very popular in the mid-nineteenth (a rival to Worcestershire sauce), and is still available today. Ingredients include the likes of anchovies, walnut pickle, soy sauce and shallots, cayenne, garlic and vinegar. An excellent, rare and unusual piece of Georgian silver.
