George Melvin Rennie studied at Gray's School of Art and Aberdeen School of Design. In the late 19th and early 20th century, he became one of Scotland's most popular landscape painters and was granted access to the Balmoral Estate. Over the next 25 years, he painted many iconic views of the Scottish residence of the British Royal Family and its 50,000 acres of surrounding Aberdeen-shire countryside. Numerous landscapes by Rennie still remain in some of the properties on the Balmoral Estate, but a great many crossed the Atlantic during the first half of the 20th century having been purchased by American visitors to Scotland.
