With a pair of carver arm chairs and four standards. Classic walnut and bergere cane. Presented in antique condition - some chairs being ready to use and others requiring restoration or upholstery. Rising from paw feet through a cabriole leg. Desirable double-U stretcher uniting the legs set. Serpentine seat frieze. Wonderful, large, moulded backs with fine scroll ended top rail. Of quality craftsmanship with attractive proportions. An imposing set of chairs offering huge possibilities. See images for further condition details. Condition Notes: All the chairs are solidly jointed and robust. The exception being one carver which has a rear-section of the stretcher missing.
