Originally a restorer of furniture, the initial output were reproductions of classic styles. Salomon's daughter, Ray, subsequently joined; she worked with the company to produce furniture to original designs. In 1932, Salomon retired and Ray took over the reigns of the business, continuing to produce spectacular designs in the contemporary style, and becoming a classic designer of the 20th century. Her husband, Mossey, assisted her with sales and administration. Pi.

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
