Description

A pretty Regency period rosewood 'CROCUS' or FLOWER TABLE with features that lead to a Gillows origin. The circular top is edged with an unusual rosewood 'petal' border, whilst the central panel is removed via the brass push-pin beneath revealing a vacant interior. It is raised on a solid turned rosewood column, with reeded knop and petal collar, leading to a triform base and solid rosewood shaped bun feet. 30ins high; 16ins wide. (76 x 40.5cms)

***These tables were used to plant small bulbs (such as crocuses) in soil, which remained dormant. A couple of weeks prior to an important party or ball. the top would be removed, the bulbs watered and they would then flower in time for the important occasion!
